



Uniform

Uniform should be worn in a clean, smart, business-like manner. It sends a clear message to others about a student's attitude to school. We ask parents and carers to give their full support in maintaining high standards of uniform in order to avoid any ambiguity regarding what is acceptable, please see the guidance in this document.

Outer clothing for girls and boys

- Outer jackets/coats, ideally waterproof, may be worn when travelling to school in inclement weather but should be in addition to, and not a replacement for the school blazer. **Hooded tops, sweatshirts, sports tops or denim are not permitted.**

Skirts & Trousers

Only grey pleated skirts are allowed; Skirt length should ensure the skirt is worn to the knee. Stretch fabric skirts are NOT allowed.

Jeans, cropped trousers, skin-tight trousers (including Leggings/jeggings/flared leggings) are not permitted for any students (boys or girls)



Shoes & Socks

Sensible black shoes which are polishable and allowed. No visible logos or branding. Ankle socks (white, grey or black) may be worn, girls are also allowed to wear tights (black or natural). Long socks are NOT acceptable



Bags & Belts

School bags should be sturdy and waterproof. The minimum size should be able to accommodate an A4 folder. No denim.

Haircuts & Make-Up

Smart appearance, NO extreme fashion statements. Hair colour must be of a natural colour spectrum. Hair Accessories/Adornments Plain single colour, discreet bobbles, scrunchies and clips may be worn to keep hair neat and tidy.

Discreet make up is permitted. No false eyelashes should be worn to school

Nails & Jewelry

These must be a natural colour only. NO coloured nail varnish. NO false / acrylic nails.

Only a chain featuring a small cross, crucifix, or religious medal is permitted, along with a watch. A single nose piercing and small stud earrings are allowed, but these must be removed during specific lessons for health and safety reasons. Rings and bracelets are not permitted.
